Online applications are invited from the eligible candidates having Bachelor Degree in Engineering and Technology/Library Science for 01-year Apprenticeship at Government Engineering College-Rajkot, Gujarat under Apprenticeship Act 1961 as amended from time to time. Details are as follows.

● **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

1. Candidates meeting the prescribed educational qualifications and medically fit under the provisions of the Apprentice Act, 1961 are eligible to apply for apprenticeship at Government Engineering College Rajkot. Eligibility further requires a full-time, regular degree in the relevant branch from a recognized university. Candidate's qualifications obtained through part-time, correspondence, distance learning, or online modes will not be considered eligible. Branch equivalency will be determined as per the Government of Gujarat Education Department Resolution No. SCT/102013/616356/GH dated 06-07-2019.
2. Candidates must not have undergone any apprenticeship previously or are not currently undergoing apprenticeship in any organization for any duration as per apprentice act 1961.
3. Only candidates from the Saurashtra region of Gujarat state — comprising the districts Rajkot, Jamnagar, Junagadh, Amreli, Bhavnagar, Porbandar, Surendranagar, Morbi, Devbhoomi Dwarka, Botad, and Gir Somnath — will be considered eligible for this Apprenticeship, as per the defined eligibility criteria.

4. Candidates submitting multiple applications or applying for more than one post will not be considered and their applications will be summarily rejected.
5. If any candidates found not eligible/ providing false information/ documents are not as required, shall be disqualified at any stage during the scrutiny process or during the period of engagement.
6. Candidates must have an active Aadhaar-linked bank account enabled for Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) as per Government of India guidelines. Registering for DBT is mandatory for all apprentices to receive the government's share of the stipend through the system.
7. Only the provisional degree certificate or the final degree certificate, duly signed and sealed by the issuing authority, will be accepted as valid proof of degree completion.
8. Upon successful verification of documents, eligible candidates will be shortlisted and invited for an interview. The interview schedule will be informed via email as an official communication channel. No TA/DA shall be paid for appearing for any of the apprentice engagement process.
9. Final selection of candidates shall be made solely on the basis of satisfactory performance in the interview, as evaluated by the Interview Committee.
10. The total tenure of the apprenticeship shall be one year from the date of joining, after which it will be terminated automatically with no provision for extension.
11. Apprentices are not allowed to enrol/undergo any regular course/job during their apprenticeship tenure.
12. Apprentices will have to follow institute timings for the working days during their apprenticeship tenure.
13. No accommodation will be provided by the Institute.
14. Apprentices will be assigned to departments based on the requirements of the institute. Assigned departments may be changed at any time during the apprenticeship to meet institutional needs.
15. Apprentices are required to undergo periodic performance evaluations and must maintain a weekly work diary. This diary is to be submitted to the designated reporting officer.
16. Upon completing the apprenticeship program, the apprentice will not have any entitlement to employment with Government Engineering College Rajkot.
17. Apprentices must maintain confidentiality of all proprietary information of Government Engineering College Rajkot and adhere to the Government of Gujarat's code of conduct and policies.
18. The Principal, Government Engineering College Rajkot, reserves the right to terminate the apprenticeship at any time for reasons including, but not limited to, absenteeism, indiscipline, misconduct, poor performance, violation of institute policies, or unauthorized absence.
19. The Principal-Government Engineering College Rajkot shall not entertain any claims of injury / accident, theft and other natural calamity or any loss inflicted during the period of apprenticeship.
20. The Principal, Government Engineering College Rajkot, reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time. Such amendments shall be deemed final and binding at the discretion of the Principal.
21. Selected graduate apprentices shall be entitled to receive a monthly stipend of ₹12,300/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand Three Hundred only), subject to satisfactory performance and attendance, and in accordance with the Apprenticeship Act, 1961 and the rules and regulations framed thereunder.

NOTE:-

- 1) A Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) of 50% of the total amount will be paid by the Government of India under the NATS scheme. Remaining amount will be paid by MAY / Establishment (Institute).
- 2) The Stipend per month will be calculated based on total days per month Attendance of apprentice on pro-rata basis.

- **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**


STEP-1: Interested candidates must **register themselves as a student** on the NATS portal (https://nats.education.gov.in/regular_student.php) and **complete or update their profile** by uploading all required documents. After registration, candidates must **apply specifically against the advertised vacancies** for **Government Engineering College, Rajkot** on the NATS portal **before the last date** of application.

STEP-2: After successfully applying on the NATS portal, candidates must also email their resume to apprentice@gecrajkot.ac.in before the last date of application.

Important : Candidates who **fail to complete any of the above mentioned steps** will be considered **ineligible**, and their application will be **disqualified**.
